Collaboration between FertiCycle researchers

Pietro, Clara, and Mario collecting soil samples from the CRUCIAL, a long-term experiment in the experimental farm of the University of Copenhagen, in Taastrup. The samples were collected before the application of bio-based fertilizers (March 2021) and during barley growing season (June 2021). In Zurich, Mario will investigate how phosphorus from different bio-based fertilizers are cycling through the soil.
