
The launch of Pilots4U heralds a boost for the bioeconomy in Europe

Rethinking glasshouse horticulture with algae



"Interreg Vlaanderen-Nederland De Blauwe Keten" (The blue chain) aims to re-boost glasshouse horticulture by expanding the existing range of products. A product that shows great potential is the microalgae Spirulina as it contains an important source of phycocyanin, which is a natural blue dye. Another aim is to valorise the produced waste streams, using duckweed. Read more.

EIP-AGRI Focus Group on Nutrient Recycling finds after-life...

The focus groups under the European Innovation Partnerships (EIP) of the European Commission have a dedicated task for 2-3 years, after which an end-report brings conclusion to the expert activities. In light of furthering collaboration and raising awareness, the Focus Group on Nutrient Recycling has decided to continue the collaboration after this period. This community group will be developed further within the larger BioRefine Cluster Europe community and will be broadened in an open-access and free-of-charge setting. More information.

Biosurf: European Renewable Gas Registry to facilitate the crossborder biomethane trade



The project has studied the conditions for opening the whole European market for biomethane distribution through the natural gas network. AgroCycle: Valorising rice bran for novel products



Research is progressing in AgroCycle as the Horizon 2020 project enters its second year. This project is evaluating agri-food waste value chains including a wide range of valorisation pathways such as biofuels and biopolymers.
