Resource Recovery A closer look to the SYSTEMIC project and outreach locations



SYSTEMIC project focuses on several technologies on resource recovery from biowaste by means of five European demonstration biogas plants operating at full scale.

Next to this, eleven large-sized anaerobic digester plants, selected as outreach locations, are strongly interested in opportunities for Nutrient Recovery and Recycling (NRR). The aim is to find out sustainable and profitable ways to prepare their business for the future.

Biogas Action aims the development of the European biogas sector and the increase of biogas and biomethane production through the ease of non-technical barriers in line with the EU 2020 targets.

<u>EBA</u> is part of the project consortium that gathered last week in Croatia to share the outcomes in the different <u>regions involved</u>. The meeting was hosted by <u>Energy Institute</u> <u>Hrvoje Pozar – EIHP</u>. Different core interventions and their replication activities in other areas were evaluated. Manure valorisation Towards End-of-Manure status to refined products



On May 30, <u>Biorefine Cluster Europe</u> (BCE) together with its member projects <u>AGROCYCLE</u> and <u>SYSTEMIC</u> organized a policy event with, and, for the European Commission to assist one of their internal assessment process called SAFEMANURE. The aim is to define the conditions that are required for animal manure to leave its legal waste / manure status. Many <u>BCE projects</u> joined the debate (PHOS4YOU, RENU2FARM, NUTRI2CYCLE, NUTRIMAN, etc.)

European projects dealing with manure valorisation want to maximise the potential of the 1,8 billion tons of manure that are annually produced in Europe. For the full policy brief resulting from the workshop see <u>here</u>.

Nutrient recycling To the moon and back - EU mission statement on nutrient recycling



Also on May 30, the <u>Biorefine Cluster Europe</u>(BCE) hosted for a workshop organized by the European Commission to explore the potential of defining Nutrient Recycling as a research mission for the upcoming Framework Programme 9 (<u>FP9-</u><u>Horizon Europe</u>).

The Commission intends to develop the new programme by following a mission-oriented approach, as proposed by the <u>Mazzucato report</u>, and will set larger societal targets over a longer time horizon, much like the "mission to the moon". This is an inclusive and expansive mission in which everyone can join!

The BCE and its partners will draft a Memorandum of Understanding considering the scope of a potential research mission under FP9. At the end of this year the BCEwill host an event in Brussels in which all potential stakeholders will contribute and so do you. So, stay tuned, and check our <u>news</u>!
