The conference will highlight the latest research and demonstration results in nutrient management and nutrient recycling, bringing together key stakeholders from across the sector.



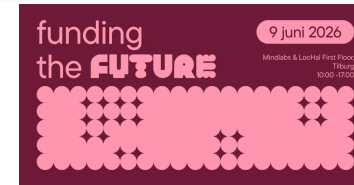
